**2022 CSI Forensic Science Course

This course is designed to introduce youth in careers in public safety, science careers supporting crime scene investigation, and an introduction into firearms and archery safety. 3. Arrivals and Departures:

The pickup and drop off area of the class is at the main entrance of IDEA and Crime Laboratory. Class monitors will be at the class from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day.

4. Personal Belongings:

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LABORATORY & CLASSROOM SAFETY CONTRACT



Participation in lab is a privilege! Students are expected to act responsibly. Consequently, any misbehavior or failure to follow directions and safety rules may lead to the student's removal from the class. Students will not be able to participate in labs unless this form is signed and in the camp administration's possession.

Lab Rules

1. No unsupervised work is allowed in the lab at anytime.
2. Students may not enter storage areas without express permission of the instructor.
3. Students are not allowed to remove anything from the classroom or lab without permission of the instructor.
4. Do not play around with the equipment!
5. Safety glasses must be worn when indicated by the instructor- no exceptions!
6. Read all lab instructions **before** beginning any experiment and take care to avoid causing an accident by sudden movements or inattention to the experiment.
- 7. Dress appropriately for lab. No open-toed shoes. Care should be taken to keep clothing and hair (tie back) from contacting heat or flames.**
8. Your lab space should be clean upon completion of the experiment.
9. Never taste chemicals. Wash hands thoroughly after every lab.
10. Follow instructor's instructions for disposal of chemicals.
11. Inform the instructor immediately of any accidents or incidents that occur. Any broken glass should be cleaned up and disposed of by the instructor.
